Actions <i>Language or Picture</i>	Consequences
Hateful - Racist, Sexist, etc.	A) Writer and writer's parent/guardian will receive a warning email
Mean – Insult, Humiliation, Taunting, Disrespectful, Rude, etc.	B) Post will be removed
Harassment - Staking, Negative Poll, etc.	C) Connection between writer and friend will be removed
Profanity	D) Writer (if child) will lose all Engage capabilities except the ability to communicate with the parent/guardian
Threats	E) Writer, if parent (with child) will lose all Engage capabilities except the ability to communicate with the child
Intimidation	F) Adult (no child) will be removed from the GPA application
